




Sex - What is your sex?







Q8 - How often of what you see on social media is related to government or politics?





Q9 - How would you describe the political viewpoints of those you follow on social media?







Q12 - What best describes you when viewing political posts on social media?






Q14 - Are these political discussions on social media typically:
